# 1. Enrollment (Schedule and Tuition):

- a) Classes are offered in **4 week** cycles in which The Student will attend **1 class per week**, each lasting **30, 45, or 60 minutes**. Each 4 week cycle begins the first week of each month.
- b) Tuition fees per 4 week cycle is as follows:

Four 30 minute classes at 240 USD (60 per class)

Four 45 minute classes at 280 USD (70 per class)

Four 60 minute classes at 320 USD (80 per class)

Single 60 minute classes are offered at 95 USD

- c) Payment is due monthly and must be made by the 5th of each month (a late fee of 25 USD will be added if an electronic payment is not submitted on or before the 5th of each month).
- d) Tuition is payable via cash, venmo (@jesse-torre-music) or zelle.

### The following dates are observed holidays in which The School will be closed:

#### 2. Cancellations:
